Submission via two ways:

Ongoing research papers: Presenting formerly unpublished motivations, goals, primary results, planned next steps, and industrial influences of an ongoing research

Research abstracts: Outlining (preferably more

mature) research of young authors, who would like to energetically engage in the forum.

In both types of proposals, we challenge the authors to believe about the potential impact of their study on industrial practice (whether in the near or far future based on the nature of the research), and to contribute a section to the Business Impact of their work. The authors of ongoing research papers will be given an industrial mentor who will evaluate the industrial impact of their work, and inform on possible impacts that the authors may be missing. The mentor's feedback will require to be manifested in the revised submission as a condition to the paper being accepted.
