“Introducing Clinical trials in Sidra Hospital”.

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Statement: Sidra Medicine, based in Doha, Qatar is the newest academic hospital in the country envisioned to be a beacon of learning, discovery and exceptional care. It's been created under the umbrella of Qatar Foundation.

Sidra is a state-of-the-art facility committed to providing women and children in Qatar with world-class tertiary healthcare services, paired with dynamic research and education environment by collaborating with its academic partners, and leading national and international research institutions.

The Research Branch of Sidra is an international biomedical research institute created in 2015, aiming to deliver translational research to the population of Qatar and the world to enhance scientific breakthroughs and personalized medicine care.

Methodology: The recently introduced Research Governance Framework presents a structured, planned and permanent approach that supports the Vision and Mission of Sidra Medicine. It describes how research operations are directed, led and controlled. Furthermore, it includes systems, principles and processes that are directed towards ensuring quality and integrity in research operations and governing the safety of all clinical research.

Findings: To support research at Sidra, a newly established Clinical Trials Office has been created within the Research Branch. CTO serves as the focal point and centralized coordinating office for all clinical research to be conducted in the hospital. The mission is to facilitate the design and conduct of ethical and scientifically valid clinical research with core administrative and operational services.

Conclusion: Sidra Medicine is striving to get the Joint Commission International accreditation as a Hospital within 2019. It is pursuing JCI accreditation as an Academic Medical Center which requires compliance with the JCI Human Subjects Research Program. The HRP purpose is to ensure that research is conducted in accordance to the protection of the rights, welfare and dignity, by providing support, guidance, and education.
